# **A Call For Immigration Reform**

For my entire life I have always heard that children are precious and should be protected by adults. This assumption was reinforced recently in the worldwide response to news that twelve young Thai boys were trapped in a dark and treacherous cave as a result of rapidly rising flood water. It took two weeks, lots of luck and resources, as well as a large team of international divers to rescue the boys.

Their rescue, followed by millions across the globe, brought joy and relief. At about the same time, a Federal Judge in San Diego was issuing an order for Homeland Security (ICE) to end the separation of families who

other countries every week. While forced migration appear to be a hopeless situation with no solution in sight, it should be noted that no country other than the United States has chosen to separate families from their children.

The United Nations, which tracks the migration of refugees and asylum world- wide, estimated more than 68 million people left their homeland in 2017. Thus forced displacement is a global issue.

Upon learning that the Trump Administration had adopted a separation of families policy, the head of the United Nations Human Rights Council stated that "Children should never be detained for reasons related to their own or their parents' migration status. Detention is never in the best interests of the child and always constitutes a child rights violation. The UN Council called on the authorities to adopt noncustodial alternatives.

Migration is a complex phenomena and many policies have been tried. However, the American separation policy appears to have been a horrible mistake. America should be and can be a model for humane migration policies and practices. The United States can also demonstrate how to treat people from neighboring countries, who are our closest

July 14th this year was the annual running of the Bulls in Pamplona Spain. Fortyfive years back in 1973, I recall backpacking Europe with some fellow international backpackers. Reminiscing about my past, I recall I showed up in Pamplona, Spain for the event on the 10th.

It was just in time for their annual week-long event. I was so excited to be in Pamplona and experience the running first hand. I had read about the popular event in school years before, and learned about the history of the celebration. I arrived by train early in the

to see the opening ceremonies first-hand the following day.

While in the town square that night before the official running, I was standing with my Australian friends who I was currently backpacking with, while a band was playing in the large gazebo in the town square directly in front of us. Believe it or not the city allowed backpackers like myself from all over Europe and the United States to actually camp out in the town square at night with sleeping bags during the annual event. Those who take part in the run now are not allowed to do so because so many young people have done it in the past that hotels complained.

The band was playing and singing "Black Magic Woman," and "Oye Como Va!" To my ecstatic surprise it was America's own Carlos Santana and his band playing. I freaked as my friends asked me who he was since they hadn't heard of him. Joyfully I informed them that Santana was a very popular band in America at that time. In 2014 President Barack Obama awarded Carlos Santana the

day awaiting my opportunity President's Award for his contributions to the music industry. Who knew? Last vear Santana performed here in San Antonio. I wasn't able to get a ticket. It would have been so cool if I did!

> Thousands of people continue to flock to Pamplona for the extravaganza every year and fill the new hotels, homes and hostels to capacity. The city relented back then and allowed the backpackers to camp out wherever they could as long as they cleaned up after themselves. The town square was ideal. In the mornings hundreds of backpackers would awake to the birds chirping and the sun shining on a new adventure, compliments of Pamplona. It was definitely an adventure to rush to the public facilities and form a line!

What I didn't know previously but learned quickly about the Running of the Bulls back then was a practice that involves running in front of a small group of cattle, typically six, of the toro bravo breed that have been let loose on a course of a sectioned-off subset of a town's streets.

The eight-day festival of adults would attempt to race San Fermines is held in honor of Saint Fermin in Pamplona although they are also traditionally held in other places. Towns and villages across Spain, Portugal and in some cities in Mexico and southern France during the summer also host a similar festival.

The origin of this event comes from the need to transport the bulls from the off-site corrals where they had spent the night, to the bull ring where they would be killed in the evening. Youngsters would jump among them to show off their bravado. In Pamplona and other places, the six bulls in the event are still those that will be featured in the afternoon bullfight on the same day.

Spanish tradition says the true origin of the run began in northeastern Spain during the early 14th century. While transporting cattle in order to sell them at the market, men would try to speed the process by hurrying their cattle using tactics of fear and excitement. After years of this practice, the transportation and hurrying began to turn into a competition, as young

in front of the bulls and make it safely to their pens without being overtaken. When the popularity of this practice increased and was noticed more and more by the expanding population of Spanish cities, a tradition was created and stands to this very day.

During my short stay in Pamplona I was informed that every so many years some runners are killed participating in the run down the streets with bulls chasing after them. I also learned numerous runners do get hurt. While I was there, one runner was gored by a bull and died later that day from his wounds. I watched from behind the fence constructed down the town streets as the participants and bulls made their way to the bull ring. Considered a sport, it is still very dangerous and not recommended for everyone to actively participate.

However, the memory etched in my mind was standing close to Carlos Santana and hearing the future Grammy winner performing "Oy Como Va" in the town square. As always, I write "Just a Thought."

#### **Construction Begins on New Alamo Colleges District Support Operations Building**

Alamo Colleges District Board Chair Dr. Yvonne Katz, Trustees Marcelo Casillas, Joe Alderete Jr. and Gene Sprague joined Chancellor Dr. Bruce Leslie, Incoming Chancellor Dr. Mike Flores and district employees to celebrate the "topping out" of the new District Support Operations Building under construction on the 12-acre former Playland Park site at 2222 N. Alamo. Two steel beams were signed by attendees and then raised by a giant crane to "top out" the building, marking a significant milestone in the construction. The complex is 40% completed and will

like 9 time WNBA All-Star Diana Taurasi from Phoenix Mercury and 11 time WNBA All-Star Sue Bird from Seattle Storm. Wilson is averaging 20 ppg along with 8 rebounds per game and is looking like their clear front runner for rookie of the year.

The reigning WNBA Champions Minnesota Lynx will be hosting this year's All-Stars at the Target Center. The game is set for Sunday, July 29th at 2:30pm on ABC.

# **;ADIOS KAWHI! Bienvenidos DeMar!**

The Spurs announced Wednesday July18 that the organization has moved on from their franchise player Kawhi Leonard. The Spurs traded the former Finals MVP Kawhi Leonard for the four time NBA All-Star Toronto Raptors guard DeMar DeRozan. The trade package included sending guard Danny Green along with \$5 million to Toronto for Raptors Center Jakob Poeltl.

The disgruntled Spurs star Leonard finally got his wish. Pop gathered his bags and sent him away, but not exactly where he preferred. Instead of the "City of Angels" to the Clippers or Lakers, he was literally sent out of the country to the home of maple syrup, Canada, more specifically the 'Los Angeles' of Canada, Toronto.

Kawhi was out all but nine games last season due to a recurring battle with a thigh injury. Kawhi averaged 16 ppg, 4 rebounds per game, and 2 assists last season. DeRozan. averaged 23 ppg, 3 rebounds per game, and a career high 5 assists per game.

Demar DeRozan expressed anger at the Raptors' organization after hearing he had been traded to San Antonio. The Raptors organization supposedly had a discussion earlier in the week stating he was not an option for a trade. According to Raptors President Masai Ujiri, there was a "gap in miscommunication" between DeRozan and the Raptors organization.

Spurs gained an All-Star in DeRozan, but also a former lottery pick in Jakob Poeltl. Poeltl was formerly the 9th pick in the 2015 NBA Draft. Poeltl averaged 6ppg, along with 4 rebounds. Not major on
