

## Google Establece un Fondo Multimillonario Para Apoyar A Familias Latinas A Que Obtengan Capacitación en Trabajos de Tecnología Sin Necesidad de un Título Universitario

Hoy Sundar Pichai, jefe ejecutivo de Google, anunció un fondo multimillonario para ofrecer becas en carreras de tecnología y apoyo integral adicional como asistencia para la vivienda, cuidado de los niños y estipendios de subsistencia. Un apoyo que ayudará a miles de familias latinas a que obtengan capacitación en trabajos de tecnología sin necesidad de un título universitario.

El fondo de certificados de carrera de Google de \$100 millones fue anunciado hoy en conjunto con la Subsecretaría de Comercio para el Desarrollo Económico de Estados Unidos, Alejandra Castillo, y los directores

ejecutivos de Social Finance, Merit América y Year Up.

La pandemia ha cambiado drásticamente el mercado laboral actual: muchos estadounidenses buscan comenzar nuevas carreras, pero los títulos universitarios tradicionales de cuatro años siguen estando fuera del alcance de muchos latinos que buscan trabajo (ya sea por el compromiso de tiempo prolongado o la perspectiva de terminar con préstamos estudiantiles bastante elevados). Mientras tanto, las empresas tienen dificultades para contratar: el 70% de los empleadores informan que tienen problemas para cubrir los puestos debido a la falta de habilidades en la fuerza laboral de Estados Unidos.

Para ayudar, Google está lanzando un Fondo de Certificados de Carrera de Google de \$100 millones de dólares con la organización sin fines de lucro Social Finance. A través de un innovador modelo de financiamiento, el programa aumentará las habilidades laborales de estadounidenses con los Certificados de carrera de Google a escala en los años venideros. Los Certificados ya han ayudado a de 70.000 estadounidenses a obtener habilidades para trabajos en análisis de datos, soporte de TI, gestión de proyectos y diseño de UX sin necesidad de título ni experiencia, y el 75% de los graduados informan un impacto profesional positivo (p. ej., nuevo trabajo, aumento o promoción).

El objetivo del fondo es generar más de mil millones de dólares en ganancias salariales agregadas durante la próxima década, y Google trabajará con MDRC para validar este impacto económico. Así es como funcionará:

Social Finance administrará el fondo y distribuirá préstamos y otorgará capital a organizaciones sin fines de lucro, incluidas Merit América y Year Up, que ya han brindado resultados exitosos para personas buscando empleo que históricamente han estado desatendidos. Esas organizaciones sin fines de lucro identificarán a los solicitantes de empleo, les darán acceso a Grow with Google Career Certificates y brindarán apoyo

integral adicional, como asistencia para la vivienda, apoyo para el cuidado de los niños y estipendios de subsistencia.

Los estudiantes solo pagan los costos del programa a través de pagos mensuales bajos si obtienen un trabajo que gana al menos \$40,000 dólares al año. Social Finance reinvertirá los reembolsos en el programa durante varios años para permitir que más estudiantes se beneficien.

Google tiene como objetivo catalizar esta alternativa a los préstamos de alto interés y alentar a otros en la industria a hacer que la capacitación sea más asequible y accesible para los estadounidenses.

# Dejounte Murray de Los Spurs fue Elegido al 2022 NBA All-Star Game

Los Spurs y su fanaticada están felices porque el guardia estelar Dejounte Murray fue convocado para ser integrante del Team Durant en la edición 71 del espectacular partido 2022 NBA All- Star.

Murray, estará supliendo al delantero Draymond Green (Golden State Warriors), quién por lesiones está ausente de la temporada.

En boletín oficial informativo de la NBA se anunció oficialmente elección de Murray, quién está cumpliendo su quinta temporada con el pentacampeón San Antonio Spurs, lo cuál será su primera participación en éste interesante partido qué marca la mitad de campaña en la NBA.

El partido a jugarse éste domingo 20 de febrero en la sede de los Cavaliers de Cleveland la arena Rocket Mortgage Fieldhouse en el horario de la 7pm (tiempo del centro).

Va a ser transmitido por la cadena televisiva TNT y ESPN Radio con audiencia en 215 países y 50 territorios en 58 idiomas.

La NBA estará a la vez celebrando su 75o aniversario. Murray, es el único jugador cuando menos en la NBA qué tiene promedio de juego con 19.0 puntos anotados por partido, así como de 8.0 rebotes y 9.0 asistencias en la presente temporada.

Murray, capitán de Spurs tiene promedio personal de 19.0 puntos, 8.4 rebotes, 9.2 asistencias y 2.06 robos de balón. Con ésa marca nunca ha habido jugador en la historia de la NBA con un promedio de 19.0 puntos, 8.0 rebotes, 9.0 asistencias y 2.0 robos durante la temporada completa.

Murray, es líder en la Liga en robos, y cuarto en asistencias. Tiene marca de 10-triples dobles, qué en la temporada lo ubica en segundo lugar debajo del líder Nicola Jokic (14) de los Nuggets de Denver.

Murray, ex jugador universitario de Huskys de Washington. Tiene marca de varios triples-dobles en lo qué va de la temporada, por arriba de ex jugadoras en la historia de Spurs (10), David Robinson "The Admiral" realizó 5 en la temporada de 1993-94 y Johnny Moore en 1984-85.

Murray, se convirtió en el primer jugador de Spurs convocado desde el 2019 cuando fue elegido el delantero LaMarcus Aldridge.

Spurs hasta ahorita tiene historia de cuando menos uno de sus jugadores han sido elegidos al All-Star Game durante 41 de los 45 All-Star Games desdén qué se afilió a la NBA en 1976, lo cuál es un récord entré las franquicias qué integran la NBA.

"Estoy agradecido porqué he recibido buenos deseos por parte de mis compañeros, aficionados, jugadores de la NBA qué en persona y por medios sociales me han apoyado porqué fui convocado al partido de estrellas. Seguiré trabajando durón en mi estilo de juego. Ello me ayudará en el futuro. Trabajo y más trabajo sobre la duela", dijo Murray.

Las elecciones para el tradicional partido fueron convocadas por los capitanes LeBron James de Lakers (Conferencia del Oeste), y Kevin Durant (Conferencia del Este) de los Nets de Brooklyn.

En el Team LeBron, dirigirá Monty Williams entrenador en jefe

de Suns de Phoenix. En el Team Durant, dirigirá Erik Spoelstra, timonel del Heat de Miami.



# Latinos in San Antonio's Westside: Fighting Poverty and Inequities

San Antonio's Westside, the poorest district in the city and one of the poorest urban communities in the United States, received some exciting news last month. The Aspen Institute and the newly created local entity ESTAR West announced a partnership designed to lift the entrepreneurial spirit of Westside residents in an effort to breathe new life into the community's economy.

The announcement event hosted by former San Antonio mayor and HUD Secretary Henry Cisneros included local community leaders long active in job creation, affordable housing, and educational opportunities. Key players in this enterprise include Janie Barrera, the long-time CEO of Liftfund; Ramiro Gonzales, the new CEO of Prosper West; and Olivia Travieso of the OCI Group.

There are approximately 2,600 small businesses in the Westside's 15 square mile area. Although Latinos account for 64 percent of San Antonio's total population, their ownership of small businesses stands at only 24 percent of all San Antonio small businesses. The majority of these businesses are

in food service/hospitality, retail, healthcare, and social assistance. The majority of Latino businesses have fewer than five employees and 80% have fewer than ten employees.

There is much ESTAR West can do to generate new economic activity in the Westside and lift its residents out of longstanding poverty status. Among ESTAR West's major objectives is to assist 30-50 businesses a year in making progress toward a 50 percent increase in revenue and profitability. With an increase in revenue, there is hope that the

businesses will hire local workers. For example, Latinos make up a large share of the construction workers in the city, but there are only a handful of construction companies based in the Westside's 78207 zip code community [hereafter Westside07].

Existing companies and startups in this industry can expect to receive equipment and training, something that ESTAR West proposes to provide over the next three years.

Solving problems facing urban communities must begin with a thorough understanding of the com-

munity, its history, its evolution, and its priorities and needs. Knowledge of the problems is an important beginning as resources are identified and invested. Only with accurate information, planning, and resources can community leaders expect to put forth solutions that address the community's most important and persistent problems.

The Westside's lowest-income sector, Westside07, is a high-density community. With an area measuring 7.3 square miles, the 78207 zip code zone encompasses half of the

Westside area of interest to the Aspen Institute and ESTAR West. The district extends west of Interstate 35 beginning at Cattleman Square and is bordered by Our Lady of the Lake University and Cupples Road. The boundaries on the North reach out to Culebra Road on the edge of Little Flower Cathedral. Its southern boundaries run along Frio City Road.

In the year 2000, the U.S Census estimated the population of the Westside07 district at 56,484 residents. In 2020 the community registered a slight decrease with a population estimate

of 56,348 [1]. Hispanics make up nearly 91 percent of the residents of this community. Whites at 5.2 percent and Blacks at 3.3 percent account for much of the remaining racial and ethnic groups [1]. The Westside07 has been losing residents for more than three decades. The districts surrounding this community are

also Hispanic majority areas and have absorbed many of the residents leaving 78207.

In the post-WWII era, Westside07 included the Avenida Guadalupe, Prospect Hill, and homes near the Brady Gardens. The community benefitted from proximity to Kelly Air Force Base and the large meatpacking Alamo City industries. The closing of Kelly Air Force base and the exodus of the large meatpackers coincided with the migration of Westside07 residents to other parts of San Antonio. In the last three decades,

the stability of the 78207 community has been very fluid with high rates of mobility. In the 1940-1960 era, Westside07 residents worked in the San Antonio downtown retail stores as well as in smaller family-owned businesses near their homes. Many of the Westside's small businesses closed their doors unable to compete with the larger mall stores. Other Latino businesses moved to the small strip malls in suburbs miles outside of the Westside.

There are many reasons for the exodus of

Westside07 residents, including a desire to be closer to jobs, better schools for their children, cheaper rents, affordable housing prices, and, in some instances, safer neighborhoods. Although housing in the Westside07 is relatively inexpensive, most of the housing is also older, with the vast majority of homes built prior to 1960. Despite a lack of

population growth, the population density of this community remains high, at 7,719 people per square mile.

In 2019, Westside07 residents reported an average income of \$27,205, significantly below the city and state

average [1]. Most residents of this community continue to work in the service and hospitality industries which pay only slightly above the minimum wage and seldom offer health and retirement benefits.

The Westside07 community is also the poorest in the city with a poverty level of 35.5 percent, a substantially higher rate than that of the state average of 13.6 percent. An estimated 83.2 percent of the Westside07 residents reported an income less than the earnings of the average San Antonian. As a consequence of this poverty, many Westside07 residents must rely on housing and food assistance from local charities and agencies. [City-Data.com]

The statistics provided by the San Antonio Food Bank reveal some of the needs resulting from income inequities of the Westside07. Westside residents were the recipients of a large proportion of the 120,000 meals per week distributed to local communities. Successfully managing such a large-scale distribution effort required a dedicated

staff numbering 260 employees aided by 72,000 volunteers. For the past twenty years, Eric Cooper, the Food Bank CEO, has managed food assistance with military-like precision that has helped many Westside07 residents provide for their families.

Good planning, execution, and precision will also be needed to create new businesses for the Westside07 community. ESTAR West acknowledges the need in the future to redevelop and activate vacant property and to improve infrastructure. ESTAR West and its part-

ners are also considering how best to attract more small businesses, entrepreneurs, customers, and visitors to the Westside. They argue that by highlighting and celebrating the Westside's historical and cultural attributes the community can become the New West, a frontier for growth and development.

Not discussed here are the pressing Westside07 educational issues which often account for the lack of good employment opportunities. These issues will be a topic for a later essay.






