And then meeting my wife at church, exactly one year later, when she returned from college. Our third daughter, for whom we and our extended family prayed fervently, when she was stricken with leukemia at 8 years old. By God's grace, she is now 27 and very healthy."

Veronica Amaro: "Yes. My two youngest boys are my miracles. I was told I couldn't get pregnant. Here they are!!"

Lisa F Santos: "Me tooooo and my Mikey turned 14 yesterday... miracle babies."

Jazmin D Zuñiga: "Life is a Miracle in the Making."

Sandra Luna Perez: "Yes, my grandson was born with 50% of his left heart chamber. He was flown to Houston Children's hospital and as I prayed and begged the Lord to please show us a miracle, it happened. The surgeon came after a couple of hours and said to the other doctors "why are we doing surgery on this baby? It's not necessary. We just have to keep a close eye on it and with time it will grow 90% normal." I fell on my knees and it was 2 days before Easter so we call him the Easter Miracle baby. Hagbard Celine: "I had a dream, we were biking back home. It was night. I remember every detail of the dream. I could see each and every detail of the things around me, as if I was actually there. In my dream, we were approaching the crossroad. From afar, I saw the green light of the bike stop lights. My boyfriend was biking before me, some three-four meters before me. The light turned orange when I was too far to make it before it turned red, but he could have made it. So he started speeding. As he started speeding to make it before it turned red, a black SUV speeded and hit him. Hard.

He was pushed off his bike and was laying on the ground. I pushed my bike aside and ran as fast as I could. I remember holding him in my arms while he was covered in blood. He was in a puddle of blood, I was on the ground, with his body in my arms, screaming and crying and knowing he was dead. An ambulance stopped, and I remember the horrible feeling of knowing he was dead. I woke up from the dream sweating. It was morning. I was shocked and relieved to see him sleeping next to me. I forgot about the dream straight away. A couple of days later, we were going back home from work. It was a quiet night, no one in the street. My ex started biking a bit before me. I was calmly following him behind. The stoplight was green as we were approaching the crossroad. It turned orange. He started speeding. That's when the dream came back to my mind. I automatically looked in the direction from where the black SUV approached in my dream. I saw the black SUV. The exact same car of my dream. I realized what was going to happen. I screamed his name on top of my lungs. I said "RUN!". He turned, and saw the car, and speeded with all of his strength, as he was already crossing when I warned him. The car didn't hit him by an inch. The car passed right before he had the green light. I was shaking in shock. I knew I had just saved his life thanks to the dream I had had. When I talked to him about it, he said it was just a coincidence. But I know it wasn't. It was too much just like my dream."

Mark Thomase: "When my older daughter was a teenager, she worried us with her partying. She would go with friends to raves in the big city 30 miles away and not be home until very late — or very early the next morning, if you get what I mean. She drank a lot, did party drugs, and slept around. We did everything we could think of to try to rein in her behavior and nothing worked. She was still a good kid, always cheerful, never given to screaming or cussing us out, and maintained good grades at school. She never fought or argued with us. She just completely ignored every rule and boundary we tried to set for her. Her mother and I were at our wits end. We did the only thing we had left to do, we prayed and prayed and prayed — prayed she'd be safe, wouldn't OD or end up in an abusive situation or car accident or any number of things we imagined could happen, prayed she'd eventually return to the "strait and narrow." One night I was awakened by someone standing next to my bed. I was instantly fully awake, looked around but didn't see anyone. Had I dreamed of it? The clock next to my bed said it was 3 AM. I laid back down to go back to sleep, when I heard a voice. "Your daughter is in danger. Pray for her." Oh! I thought. But the voice went on. "And so you will know that you're not imagining this, there will be a major airline merger announced tomorrow morning." And that was all. No more voices, no more presence next to my bed. I got out of bed and

checked my daughter's room; unsurprisingly her bed was empty. I sat on the sofa in the living room and prayed for her safety and eventually went back to bed. But I didn't go back to sleep. Perhaps I dozed, but at 4 AM I heard the screen door open and my daughter creep in quietly. I met her in the hallway. "Where were you about an hour ago?" I asked, more out of curiosity than with any intention to scold. "I was out with friends. Why?" "Because about an hour ago I got woken up by an angel who told me to pray for you because you were in danger." Daughter didn't answer. She just got an odd look on her face, went into her room, and closed the door.. In a couple of hours I was up again, this time, getting ready to go to work, and I remembered the second thing the angel told me. When I got to work that morning, I got off the bus and looked at the newspaper rack next to the bus stop. The headline of the Wall Street Journal was that Air Canada had agreed to merge with Canadian Airlines. "Wow," I thought. I was also the youth leader at a large church, and we were organizing a trip to an event called "Acquire the Fire" in the city 30 miles away. Thousands of kids packing out an old hockey arena, watching a Christian-themed drama. I invited Daughter, knowing she'd turn me down, when, to my surprise, she didn't. She agreed to come. At the end of the "Acquire the Fire" event they made an evangelistic plea for anyone present to commit their lives to Jesus, either for the first time or as a rededication, or to commit to missions or ministry, and asked anyone wanting to make that decision and speak to a counselor to come forward. Soon, dozens of kids were streaming out of the stands and down to the floor of the arena, and I was praying for my daughter harder than I'd ever prayed for her in my life. And still, it was a surprise when she actually stood up and made her way down to the altar on the floor of the coliseum. There, she later told us, she recommitted her life to Christ, and in the next few weeks we saw her quitting booze and drugs cold turkey and spending more time with her Christian friends instead of her raver group. But what surprised me most was once when she was asked to give her testimony before a group, not the youth group I still led but another one. She went into all the details of the parties and the raves and the drinking and drugs. And then she said this: "And then one night, I was out with this boy I didn't even know. He was drunk, so drunk he shouldn't be driving, and we were speeding through the mountains. I was scared to death, I kept thinking that he was going to drive right off the cliff and kill us all. But we made it home OK, and when I walked in the back door like I always did, there was my dad standing there. He told me he'd been awakened by an angel and told to pray for my safety. I didn't say anything to him, I was just speechless. But that night I started realizing that there was a God who loved me enough to get my dad out of bed just so he could pray for me. And that was the night I started coming back to the Lord."





DEBUNKING COMMON MYTHS ABOUT VOUCHER HOLDERS

MYTH: Voucher holders are "bad" tenants likely to damage units and not pay rent on time. There are strong incentives for voucher holders to be good tenants that are built into the HCV program. Many households wait years to receive their voucher and they realize they could lose it if they damage the unit, do not pay rent on time, or are evicted for a similar reason.

MYTH: Voucher holders bring crime to properties and their surrounding communities.

Studies find no evidence that an increase in households using vouchers results in increased crime in a neighborhood. Rather, households with vouchers tend to move to areas where crime is already high.

MYTH: Accepting vouchers will negatively impact property values.

Similarly, studies find no evidence that increased voucher use causes property values to decline in higher-income neighborhoods.

Housing Choice Vouchers are one of the most important tools for achieving housing stability for low-income people. But an absence of regulation allows landlords to discriminate based on false assumptions, and keeps the program from being able to help low-income people access decent housing in a quality neighborhood.

SOLUTIONS: SOURCE OF INCOME PROTECTION

Source of income (SOI) protection can help ensure HCV holders' ability to access decent housing in a neighborhood of their choice. SOI protection laws prohibit rental property owners from denying prospective tenants on the basis of their source of income, including federal benefits like HCV vouchers and Social Security. Jurisdictions can be allowed to protect SOI locally or a state can protect SOI statewide. SOI protection can also be written into HOA law.




MOST HCV HOLDERS END UP IN LOW-INCOME NEIGHBORHOODS IN SAN ANTONIO

Many landlords refuse to accept vouchers, often due to false ideas and stereotypes regarding people who use vouchers.⁴ Because of a lack of options where they can use their voucher to rent, **voucher holders cluster in the city's lowest income areas.**



Many landlords refuse to accept vouchers, often due to false ideas and stereotypes regarding people who use vouchers.⁴ Because of a lack of options where they can use their voucher to rent, **voucher holders cluster in the city's lowest income areas.**

Devin Vassell, guardia y alero de 23 años de edad, con estatura de 6'5", nativo de Suwanee, Georgia, quién fue elegido por los Spurs durante el 2020 NBA Draft en el 11º escaño, tras haber jugado dos temporadas con Florida State University, dónde fue electo al All-ACC Second Team y por haber guiado a los Seminoles a su primera ACC temporada regular

campeonato en la historia del plantel durante su segunda temporada colegial.

Vassell, con tres años con Spurs de valioso prospecto decidió quedarse en San Antonio qué le ha ofrecido todo tipo de oportunidades para sobresalir en su carrera deportiva y personal.

Vassell, firmó contrato por 5 años en cantidad monetaria no especificada de acuerdo a boletín informativo de Spurs

Sports and Entertainment (SS&E). Qué tiene su foja de 18.5 puntos, 3.9 rebotes y 3.4 asistencias de su tercera temporada. En 171 partidos jugados Vassell tiene promedio de 11.2 puntos, y 3.7 rebotes en 24.4 minutos sé jugó por cotejo. Con 292 tiros triples, en su temporada de novato Devin destacó encuestando 1,000 puntos con 123 triples y 100 robos de balón. Marca qué lo unió a los grandes guardias Tony Parker y Manu Ginobili.

Por otro lado los Spurs de San Antonio, en coordinación con su fundación Spurs Give y San Antonio Parks Foundation, [SP&F] inauguraron renovación de cancha de baloncesto en el popular Acme Park, con patrocinio con City of San Antonio Parks and Recreation Department, San Antonio Police Department (SAPD), y Police Athletic League [PAL].

Latino Artists Display Borderland Themes at Chicano Park Museum

The Son de Allá y Son de Acá exhibit at Chicano Park Museum in San Diego opens at a moment when United States immigration policy is in turmoil. Reuters reported last week that President Joe Biden's administration would "add sections to a border wall to stave off record migrant crossings from Mexico, carrying forward a signature policy of former President Donald Trump," [Oct. 6, 2023]. A return to a failed border wall project shocked residents living along the 2,000-mile U.S.-Mexico border.

The inhabitants of the U.S.-Mexico border

regions confront the issue of immigration almost on a daily basis. However, many things about immigration have changed over the past decade. Former President Donald Trump's decision to build a border wall was

the most controversial immigration policy of the past century and the most damaging environmental action ever for border communities.

What has also changed over the past decade is that migration into the United States is no longer just a border issue. Conservative governors from Texas and Florida are weekly transporting newly arrived migrants by the thousands to "san-

tuary cities" including Los Angeles, Chicago, and New York City. Still, 70 percent of Americans surveyed by a recent Gallup poll considered immigration to be good for the United States.

Moreover, new immigration studies show that migrants arriving on the U.S.-Mexico border are no longer principally from Mexico. A Pew Report noted that immigrants from countries other than Mexico accounted for 63 percent of those crossing the border. Pew Researchers found that most of the non-Mexican migrants "involved people from the Northern Triage countries of Honduras, Guatemala, and El Salvador." Other prominent migrant groups included Venezuelans, Haitians, and Cubans.

The changing perception of the immigration

landscape can be found in a new exhibit Son de Allá y Son de Acá at the Chicano Park Museum in Barrio Logan, San Diego, California. The exhibit, which opened this past weekend, features 45 artists from the states of California, Arizona, New Mexico, and Texas.

The artists in this new exhibit live and work in the Borderlands. Artist Mata Ruda from Phoenix, Arizona was

recently featured in Phoenix New Times as one of the 10 Arizona artists who "Put Immigration Front and Center." The newspaper noted that one of his murals depicts a mother "holding a photograph of her daughter who died while attempting to cross the U.S.-Mexico bor-

der." Ruda's work included in the Son de Allá y Son de Acá exhibit is titled "The memory of this moment will haunt me forever, a tropical moon, a sleepy lagoon and you."

Another artist featured in the Chicano Park exhibit, Alejandro Macias, was raised in the border town of Brownsville, Texas and now teaches art at the University of Arizona, Tucson. His website notes that his "body of work addresses themes of heritage, immigration, and ethnicity, which are set in contrast to his critical engagement with the assimilation and acculturation process often referred to as 'Americanization.'" In 2021, I saw one of Macias's paintings of an anonymous male figure with colorful linear serape-like imagery in place of a face wearing a cap that read "Immigrants Make America Great."

A similar painting of a portrait of a man wearing the same shirt with the sky in place of his eyes and head is in the Chicano Park Museum exhibit and is titled "And

Then It Dawned On Me."

The Los Angeles cartoonist Lalo Alcaraz is undoubtedly the best-known artist in the San Diego Son de Allá y Son de Acá exhibit at Chicano Park Museum. A two-time Pulitzer Prize finalist, Alcaraz is the first Latino to

receive the prestigious Washington Post Herblock Prize. Michael Cavna of the Washington Post reported on Alcaraz's 2022 prize ceremony noting the judges' comments that "No other political cartoonist working in the U.S. brings as much passion, dedication and brilliance to the fight for fair immigration at the border and justice for the Latino community." In the January 6 Washington D.C. insurrection attempt, school book bans, and protests highlighting workers' rights and border immigration the Latino cartoonist found more than enough material to satirize.

Alcaraz is also one of the few Latinos ever featured in the New Yorker magazine. Graciela Mochkofsky's thoughtful essay, "Lalo Al-

caraz and the Long Journey of a Latino Political Cartoonist" in the May 18, 2022 New Yorker speaks volumes about the very successful career of Alcaraz. As noted by Mochkofsky, his journey has been long, and it has not been without great difficulties.

Alcaraz grew up in San Diego, the son of immigrants from Sinaloa and Zacatecas. His father, who worked as a gardener, died in a car accident when Alcaraz was thirteen. Alcaraz attended San Diego State University [SDSU] in the mid-1980s earning a degree in art with a focus on environmental design. He joined the SDSU

school newspaper and drew cartoons focusing on politics and

culture. From San Diego State, Alcaraz went on to study architecture at UC Berkeley. While in the Bay Area, he co-created a comedy group, the Chicano Secret Service.

Alcaraz moved to Los Angeles after finishing his studies at UC Berkeley. He joined the staff of L.A. Weekly, a popular Southern California alternative magazine. At the L.A. Weekly Alcaraz created "L.A. Cucaracha," a comic strip, which ran for ten years and since 2002 has been nationally syndicated in


more than sixty newspapers as "La Cucaracha." Alvarez told the New Yorker that the main character, Cuco Rocha, is "such an angry Chicano activist that he turned into a cockroach."

Alcaraz gained national attention as a vocal opponent of Governor Pete Wilson's support of Proposition 187, an anti-immigrant state legislative initiative. [Prop. 187 eventually was found to be unconstitutional]. Alcaraz turned to other art forms when his cartoon of Migra Mouse was placed on placards and used at


anti-Proposition 187 protest rallies. Alcaraz transformed Mickey Mouse into Migra Mouse, a slightly unlovable character dressed in a Border Patrol uniform.

Alcaraz is a multi-talented cartoonist who also performs in plays and is known to create controversial art pieces. In the late 1990s, he painted Che Guevara with a Nike icon on Che's famous beret replacing the communist star symbol with the widely recognized Nike checkmark. Ricardo Duardo, the inventive Chicano artist and talented East Los Angeles printer, arranged for Alcaraz to print a limited edition of the Che piece. Harriett and I bought one of these fabulous prints in the 1990s. We included this silkscreen print in our Chicano art exhibit Estampas de la Raza curated by the McNay Art Museum in 2013. The exhibit, which includes Alcaraz's piece and 60 other Latino prints, has traveled to numerous cities including Los Angeles, Chicago, and Albuquerque. Last week the Estampas exhibit closed in Sacramento and is currently opening in Atlanta, Georgia.

Alcaraz's painting in the Son de Allá y Son de Acá exhibit portrays the iconic

Chicano activist Oscar Zeta Acosta, author of The Revolt of the Cockroach People. Dartmouth Professor Israel Reyes, who has written about Alcaraz's work, told the New Yorker that the cockroach "is a metaphor of how immigrants, Mexicans, have been represented as insects, as a nuisance, as space invaders, the Latino threat to be eliminated." Alcaraz appropriates the concept of the

cucaracha and turns it upside down as "a way of empowering through this image that was used to marginalize." Alcaraz credits Acosta for influencing the name of his comic strip L.A. Cucaracha.

The Chicano Park exhibit is making an important statement by bringing together these Latino artists to continue to raise issues of social justice. Adelante Barrio Logan y San Diego!



Un paciente que contrae la influenza y también otras enfermedades tales como diabetes o hipertensión, tiene un potencial de desarrollar complicaciones graves cuando se recupera del virus. Esto incluye un aumento en la gravedad de los síntomas, con el posible riesgo de hospitalización o incluso muerte.

Los adultos mayores son especialmente susceptibles a las complicaciones relacionadas con la gripe. Las estadísticas han demostrado que las vacunas contra la gripe ofrecen amplios beneficios a personas de todas las edades.

También contribuyeron al aumento de casos de gripe del año pasado las dudas entre el público para vacunarse contra la gripe después de dos años de vacunas Covid, la disminución del uso de máscaras y la reducción del distanciamiento social.

Actualizaciones de la Vacuna Contra la Influenza 2023

Se espera que este año sea fuerte e impredecible. Afortunadamente, la vacuna contra la gripe se actualizó con las últimas cepas de gripe que vimos más en los Estados Unidos el año pasado.

La vacuna contra la gripe ayuda a construir anticuerpos contra cuatro cepas diferentes de virus. Los anticuerpos naturales de las personas tienen un poder limitado para combatir las cepas de la gripe debido al debilitamiento con el tiempo. Pero con el apoyo de una vacuna contra la gripe, el cuerpo puede aumentar el número de anticuerpos y mejorar las posibilidades de reducir la gravedad de la enfermedad.

Mi consejo para las personas mayores es que se vacunen

contra la gripe hoy mismo. No espere hasta el último minuto, porque podría ser demasiado tarde. Tenga en cuenta que no está completamente protegido hasta después de dos semanas de recibir la vacuna contra la gripe, porque el sistema inmunológico necesita tiempo para desarrollar anticuerpos.

Otra razón para vacunarse contra la gripe, es que TAMBIÉN estará protegiendo su bolsillo. Un aumento de anticuerpos para luchar contra la gripe significa que hay una menor probabilidad de requerir tratamiento, lo cual podría reducir sus gastos médicos.

Protéjase: Vacuna Contra la Gripe + Refuerzo de Covid + Más

La investigación muestra que es seguro para los pacientes recibir sus vacunas de refuerzo contra la gripe y Covid al mismo tiempo. Ya sea juntas o no, recibir tanto la vacuna contra la gripe como el refuerzo Covid mejorará las posibilidades de que su sistema inmunológico combata las infecciones.

A principios de 2020, cuando comenzó Covid, el mandato de usar máscaras protectoras, practicar el distanciamiento social y adherirse a la higiene personal, como lavarse las manos, contribuyó a una disminución en los casos de gripe. Esto significaba que había menos personas que contraían la gripe, porque todos tomaban precauciones.

Otra vacuna importante para las personas mayores es la vacuna contra el virus sincitial respiratorio, o vacuna contra el VSR, que protege contra la infección por el virus sincitial respiratorio. Al igual



que la gripe, el VSR es un virus respiratorio común que generalmente causa síntomas leves parecidos al resfriado. Es una enfermedad estacional, que generalmente comienza en el otoño y alcanza su punto máximo en el invierno. El VSR causa síntomas leves de resfriado en la mayoría de las personas, pero puede provocar hospitalización e incluso la muerte en personas mayores y bebés.
